Staff Update

Michelle Traver thanked Alicia Hamilton, Matt Menely, and Gary Michael for attending the recent Milwaukie Monthly Light Rail meeting. Eleanor Hunter reported that her briefing of the Oak Lodge Community board on Seyed Alavi's proposal for Park Ave evoked a positive response. On May 25, Seyed will present his proposal to the Oak Lodge Community Council. Thom Faulders will present his proposal for Kellogg Bridge to the Milwaukie Design and Landmarks Commission on June 1.

The next Art Advisory Committee has been rescheduled for June 22. There will be no meeting in July.

Preliminary Concept Presentation: Bybee Blvd Station

Dana Lynn Louis presented her preliminary concept for the Bybee Blvd Station. Committee comments were favorable regarding the idea of the motion lantern and use of light projection. Members agreed that the column treatment should be simplified and should relate to the other artwork at the station.

The committee approved the preliminary concept contingent on review of a draft budget. The budget must include estimates for artwork as well as infrastructure costs. The committee also agreed upon the following direction:

- Continue to collaborate with architect on design of lantern tower
- Create unique station windscreen pattern for windscreens on bridge and platform
- Design mosaic pattern for shelter columns that ties into lantern imagery
- Develop proposal for projections.

### Revised Concept: Lake Rd Station

Michelle presented Brian Goldbloom's revised concept for the north entrance of Lake Rd Station. Committee members noted that it was improved but agreed that the relationship between the framework and the stonework is still not resolved. They did not approve the revision.
